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RESOLUTION NO. R-104-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLTON, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING FEES FOR ADMINISTERING THE TOBACCO RETAILER'S LICENSE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2019, the City Council conducted first reading for the adoption of Ordinance No. O-13-19, which added Chapter 5.55 to the Colton Municipal Code, placing additional regulations and licensing requirements on tobacco retailers located in the City of Colton; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted a nexus analysis of the Tobacco Retailer's License fees to ensure that said fees accurately reflect the cost of performing services required to administer the License application, renewals, extensions of time, appeals and compliance monitoring processes; and

WHEREAS, a properly noticed public hearing was conducted on November 5, 2019 to receive public comments on the proposed fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Colton does hereby find, determine and declare as follows:

SECTION 1. Adoption of Fees. The flat fees for the administration of the Tobacco Retailer's License Program are hereby adopted as follows:

- Application and Renewal of Tobacco Retailer's License: \$265.00
- Application for Extension of Time (Nonconforming Use): \$168.00
- Appeals of Application Denial: \$388.00

SECTION 2. Supporting Evidence & Study. The adoption of this Resolution is based on all oral and written evidence prepared by and/or presented to the City, including but not limited to, the Fees Nexus Analysis, prepared by the City with input from all affected parties. This study, which documents that the Tobacco Retailer's License Fees do not exceed the cost to the City of providing noted services, is hereby accepted by the City Council.

SECTION 3. CEQA Findings. The City Council hereby finds that, in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the CEQA Guidelines, the adoption of this Resolution is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3).

SECTION 4. Effective Date of Resolution. The Mayor shall sign this Resolution and the City Clerk shall attest thereto, and thereafter this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
